About Pathways

The Pathways Team provides a supportive, individualised service to people with acquired brain injury, assisting them to navigate service systems and build life skills.

Our experienced and qualified team of workers can help you with a wide range of issues.

Pathways Services

Finance

- Assisting individuals to manage their finances, ensuring they are receiving appropriate income support, eligibility for concessions, budgeting support and referrals to financial counsellors if required.
- Debt negotiation including fines and establishing payment plans. Establishment of Centrepay options to reduce risk of debt.

Education

- Assistance to enrol in educational programs that will build capacity, linking individuals to student support services.

Centrelink

- Assess eligibility for Centrelink payments, including sourcing suitable evidence of diagnosis, treatment and functional capacity. Ensuring you are on the most suitable payment and receiving correct entitlements.

Employment

- Assistance to determine eligibility for various employment services including support for Job Capacity Assessments at Centrelink and referral to DES and Supported Employment options.

Community Connection and Recreation

- Facilitating community integration and linking in with supports and groups.

Legal

- Exploring Guardianship and Administration orders with SACAT.
- Linking people to legal advice and information so they can make informed decisions.

Housing

- Support with applications for community housing and applying for private rental.
- Assistance to maintain tenancies including referrals to support services if required.

Personal Administration

- Support to establish routines and systems at home, ensuring appointments are scheduled and household tasks addressed.

- Have an acquired brain injury (ABI)
