About us

Brain Injury SA (BISA) is both a Peak Body and a Service Provider working to address the needs of people living with Acquired Brain Injury (ABI).

This includes all people who experience multiple disabilities arising from damage to the brain acquired after birth, resulting in deterioration in cognitive, physical, emotional or independent functioning. It can be as a result of accidents, stroke, brain tumours, infection, poisoning, lack of oxygen, degenerative neurological disease etc.

We support people to embrace life after brain injury.

We do this by offering a person-driven, interdisciplinary approach, where our clients are at the centre of all goal setting and decision-making in their recovery journey.

As a peak body, we also have a wider role within the community as an advocative voice that aims to influence at a state and national level for systemic change, as well as offering individual advocacy support to people with an ABI.

Advocacy

Individual assistance to give voice to people with ABI when they need help to be heard on things impacting them.

NDIS Appeals

Assisting people not satisfied with a reviewable decision made by the NDIA.

Pathways Services

Personalised support to help build life skills and better access community facilities and services.

Training & Education

Building skills and knowledge of ABI for the team around an individual.

Rewire Therapy Services

An interdisciplinary service to help you achieve your goals.

Finding & Keeping a Job

Assistance to create a clear pathway to employment after brain injury.

Social & Community Participation

Help with accessing your needs in community and doing the things you want to be able to do socially.

Therapeutic, Social & Educational Groups

Offering a range of different groups to support you in your journey.

Case Management

Working with individuals and their families to tailor support and services to meet their needs.

Positive Behaviour Support

Assisting those living with ABI and their carers to best manage behaviours that create barriers to success.

BISA Connect

Time limited block therapy for adults without a current funding source.

Peer Mentoring Program

Connecting people with lived-experience helping to reduce isolation and promote optimism.
